

Only the most stable heartwood portions of each log are selected from trees that have grown for over a century before they are harvested. Jensen timber is then slowly cured in

kilns for up to 65 days to assure dimensional stability and a lifetime of outdoor service.

By using only FSC® certified wood, Jensen Leisure Furniture is working to maintain the longterm well-being of the forests and the people who depend on them. The Ipé used in Jensen Leisure Furniture is certified to meet criteria of the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC®), a non-profit organization that sets international standards for responsible forestry. By sourcing materials in this manner, Jensen Leisure Furniture is helping to conserve tropical forests and enhance the standard of living in its surrounding communities.

ENVIRONMENT

The Forest Stewardship Council[®] is an independent, non-profit organization established in 1993 to promote the responsible management of the world's forests. Since its inception, over 460 million acres of forest have been certified worldwide (an area larger than the state of Alaska).

Products carrying the FSC® label are independently certified to assure consumers that they come from forests that are managed to meet the social, economic and ecological needs of present and future generations.

FSC® certification gives forestry enterprises access to new markets for their wood products, and a means for providing steady employment to their workers. But even more importantly, community members become the forest's staunchest defenders when sustainable management provides an alternative to people who depend on the land.

IPÉ COLLECTION PRODUCT CARE & MAINTENANCE

Some of the world's strongest and most durable woods come from the Chiquitania Dry Forest of Eastern Bolivia. Because of the nature of tropical dry forests, trees grow very slowly here. Ipé is one of the most abundant timber species in these forests. It is incredibly strong and dense, with very high wear durability.

A rich chocolate-brown color when new, the sun gracefully transforms Ipé to a mature, elegant silver patina. The original color remains preserved, however, just beneath the "skin" of the weathered surface. You can choose to allow your furniture to weather naturally or preserve the original color through simple maintenance.

To preserve the original color, we recommend and supply Penofin Verde, a special oil finish. It contains a light transparent pigment that screens the UV light and enhances the tone and hue of Ipé without hiding the grain. It is simple to apply using a lint-free cloth, sponge, or even spray bottle. In average climates, it is sufficient to recoat fully exposed furniture once a year. More frequent re-coating may be needed in regions with high sunshine. Our website

features detailed instructions on how to care for your lpé furniture.

For additional protection from water and moisture, we recommend and supply Wood Shield. Applied to Ipé or Roble tabletops, Wood Shield will provide protection from household food stains—wine, olive oil, grease stains, water spotting, etc.


Wood is a living material, sensitive to the constant changes of the outdoor environment. Although Ipé is naturally stable, minute checks in the wood surface may appear if the furniture is placed in very dry or sunny environments for prolonged periods. Superficial checking in no way effects the structural integrity or longevity of your furniture.



Roble is a native hardwood from Eastern Bolivia. It has been known for decades in Europe as a premium garden furniture wood and is highly valued for its outdoor stability and durability. The large size of Roble trees allows for wide board and clear cuttings of 100% heartwood, the most durable part of the tree. All Jensen Leisure Furniture Roble is FSC® 100%.








































ARGENTOCOLLECTION

Crafted of 100% FSC® Certified Roble heartwood the Argento (silver in Italian) finish is low-maintenance, requiring no special care other than recommended Wood Shield as it ages outdoors to a medium gray.

The timber surface is distressed, with areas sanded smooth, to provide a weathered driftwood appearance.

The Argento finish was designed to be "low maintenance", meaning that the finish is designed to continue to gray-out as it weathers, closely approximating the original gray appearance needing no maintenance whatsoever. If however, the wood surface becomes dirty or stained with outdoor use, you can use Argento Aftercare to return the finish to a clean gray condition.


CORAL COLLECTION
